The California Domestic Partner Rights and Responsibilities Act extends new rights, benefits, responsibilities and obligations registered with the California Secretary of State under section 221 of this Family Code. If you are in a registered domestic partnership, you are treated as an independent married student to determine eligibility for this fee waiver and will need to provide income of partner. If you are a dependent student and your parent is in a Registered Domestic Partnership, you will be the parents and income and household information will be required for the parents' domestic partner. (These new provisions not to federal student financial aid.)
